SOME KEY CHARACTERISTICS OF COMMUNITY CLINICS WE WOULD LIKE TO SEE BY 2015

- Please select one member of your group to moderate your conversation and another to take notes and report your conclusions.
- Over dinner we'd like each group to identify some practical steps that clinics could take to achieve the following objectives:
 - Attracting and keeping the newly insured, who will now have more choices
 - Building capacity and financial stability (e.g., through collaboration and better coordination with other clinics and with the larger health care delivery system)
 - Helping to improve the health of the community (e.g., through increased focus on prevention, public health campaigns, better communications, etc.)
 - Other?

- As you work, please try to follow the ground-rules for dialogue. If you come up against a serious disagreement that you cannot work through in the time available, just note it and move on.
